

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 205.020 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF COUNTRY CLUB, MISSOURI IN REGARDS TO THE ANNUAL REGISTRATION FEE FOR DOG LICENSES.

WHEREAS, on September 8, 2015, the Board of Trustees ("Board") of the Village of Country Club, Missouri (the "Village") voted to increase the dog license fee from \$1.00 to \$10.00 annually per dog; and

WHEREAS, there is no record that the Ordinance was updated based on the Board's motion; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds it is in the best interest of the residents of the Village to revise the Municipal Code to show the increased fee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF COUNTRY CLUB as follows:

1. That Sections 205.020.B and C of the Municipal Code of the Village of Country Club, Missouri are hereby deleted in their entirety and replaced with the following:

SECTION 205.020 VACCINATION AND TAG

B. *Fee for Registration.* The annual registration fee for each dog registered pursuant to Subsection (A) shall be the sum of ten dollars (\$10.00).


C. *Duplicate Registration Tags.* In case of loss, a duplicate registration tag shall be issued by the Clerk of the Board of Trustees for the sum of ten dollars (\$10.00).

2. That this Ordinance shall take effect from the time of its passage and approval as provided.
